Birth Anniversary of India's First Lady Teacher

ICERT on the occasion of the birth anniversary of Savitribai Phule organized a One-Day International Symposium on "Recent Trends in Education and Its Relevance with Savitribai Phule's ideas" on January 03, 2023.

The major objectives of the conference were:

- 1. To create awareness about the work and life of Savitribai Phule to overcome social, economic, and psycho-social barriers.
- 2. To facilitate youth and faculty who are making a remarkable contribution toward social welfare.
- 3. To motivate the young students to know and follow the philosophical thoughts of Savitribai Phule.
- 4. To provide support to researchers in the new domains of education and social welfare by relating the new ideas with Savitribai Phule's philosophy and work.

January 3 marks the birth anniversary of Savitribai Phule, known for her contribution to the field of women's education, Savitribai Phule was born on January 3, 1831, in Maharashtra's Satara district in a country ruled by the Britishers, where women's rights were non-existent. She is widely regarded as a woman teacher who campaigned to create awareness of the need for education for women. A feminist icon, Phule fought against patriarchy and casteism and faced countless hardships in the process. The **first woman teacher**, who was way ahead of her times and the first female educationist of India was also the first female poetess. She wrote a poem entitled 'Go, Get Education' which encouraged people to free themselves from oppression by educating themselves.
