Rise of the concept of Interdisciplinarity



- Interdisciplinarity has since been promoted by several movements. One of these is the Unity of Science movement which campaigned in the 1930s and 1940s in the West.
- The search for "grand and simplifying concepts" such as the second law of thermodynamics, mass-energy equivalence, quantum mechanics and general systems theory have also promoted Interdisciplinarity, (Klein 2000).
